

Wanaka Sled Dog Festival 2014

27th – 30th August 2014 - "Snow Farm", Wanaka

Go for the SNOW at the Wanaka Sled Dog Festival, to be held at the Pisa Alpine Charitable Trust's 'Snow Farm', Wanaka.

Format:

The event format for this year will be four individually sanctioned races, with thanks to the Australasian Sled Dog Club for use of their sanctionings. The format is as follows:

Wanaka Sled Dog Festival I

Race One – Wednesday 27th August (evening) * Race Two – Thursday 28th August (morning) *

Wanaka Sled Dog Festival II

Race Three – Friday 29th August (evening) * Race Four – Saturday 30th August (morning)

* The results for Wanaka Sled Dog Festival I, will be based on the combined overall times of Race One and Race Two. The results for Wanaka Sled Dog Festival II will be based on the combined overall times for Race Three and Race Four. To qualify for prizes entrants must finish the two races, in the same class, with the same dogs throughout.

Entrants are welcome to enter only one race, or change classes and/or dogs but will not be eligible to qualify for overall prizes and trophies. However, you will receive certificates for class placing in each individual race, and minor prizes.

Classes/Trails/Distances:

The 2014 Wanaka Sled Dog Festival has NZFSS sanctioning and will be run under NZFSS race rules. Classes available are 2, 3, 4 and 6 dog sled, and single dog ski-joring. Depending on entry numbers dual starts may be used.

Please note if you are entering the ski-joring class this is run under the IFSS rules as per the remit passed at the 2011 NZFSS AGM. Please ensure you have read these rules and are familiar with the required equipment.

Distances will be 4-6km approx per heat for 1 & 2 dog and up to 12km per heat for 3, 4, & 6 dog. Distances are dependant on snow and weather conditions.

The race organizers reserve the right to reduce any team size should they feel the musher is trying to control a team beyond their capabilities.

Novice Snow Mushers:

All NOVICE (WSDF) snow entrants and those entering the sledding section for the first time must attend the compulsory novice mushers meeting at 12.30pm on Wednesday 27th August.

WSDF Trophies:

Wanaka Sled Dog Festival Trophies will be awarded based on the results of Wanaka Sled Dog Festival I. To qualify for trophies entrants must finish Race One and Two, in the same class, with the same dogs throughout.

Pee-Wee's Race:

A fun pee-wee's race will be held in conjunction with the first three races. Refer race time-table for approximate start times. Please register for pee-wee's on this entry form.

Raffle:

There will be a raffle – so bring along a few extra dollars! Raffle to be drawn at prize giving on Saturday 30th August.

NZFSS Insurance:

In order for participants to be covered by the NZFSS Insurance they must be a financial member of a Sled Dog Club recognized by the NZFSS or become a temporary member for the race duration. A declaration to this effect has been added to the entry form.

Race Officials:

We are pleased to have Michael Herbst from Australia who is the IFSS Continental Director join us as Race Marshall this year.

Beth Campbell will be on site again this year as our Vet.

Special Event:

Curt and Fleur Perano of Team Itasca will be joining us to give a talk on their experiences of mushing overseas. Both Curt & Fleur had their first taste for Snow at the Wanaka Sled Dog Festival! Curt is one of an elite group of mushers to finish both the Yukon Quest (7th place) & Iditarod (23rd place) in the same season. In 2011 Curt placed 1st in the Race to the Sky, the Team has also been awarded the 'Best Cared for Team' at two events. Come along and meet Curt and Fleur, a great opportunity not to be missed!

Prize-Giving:

Prize Giving will be held on Saturday 30th August, at the SHPG / Snow Farm Lodge (upstairs). This will be held as soon as possible after completion of the event at approximately 11.15am.

Accommodation:

Entrants are responsible for arranging their own accommodation. There are various holiday houses and some motels/hotels in Wanaka that accept dogs. On site accommodation at the Snow Farm is available, email info@snowfarmlodge.com for bookings.

Entry Close Off:

Entries must be returned by Friday 25th July to avoid late fee penalty. Entries post marked after this date will incur a late entry fee of an additional \$30.00 per entry and will not be able to order T-Shirts and may not be eligible for entry in the catalogue.

Entries post marked after Friday 1st August will not be accepted.

You will receive a confirmation letter to confirm your entry.

NB: An entry is not deemed to be received until the fee is paid in full.

Please Note: All race times are approximate being dependant on temperature and conditions on the day.

Please Note the Following Important Information:

- > It is compulsory for all mushers to have adequate lighting as this may be required; this must include a forward facing light attached to the sled or musher and a red rear facing flashing light.
- It is recommended that all sleds are fitted with a drag mat. Sleds must also have a snow hook that is capable of securing your team adequately.
- ➤ No musher/entrant is to leave the Snow Farm after each race with out consent of the Vet or Race Marshall. This is to ensure all teams have been given vet clearance.
- > Start intervals will be 1 minute.
- > While you are present at the Snow Farm, please obey the following:
 - Dogs are to be kept on a leash and are NOT allowed into accommodation
 - Dogs must not be left unattended when tied up
 - REMOVE ALL DOG POOS! Dog poo is not to be put in the rubbish bins at the Snow Farm.
 - Chains must be carried for ALL vehicles
- As a requirement of our safety plan, although helmets are not compulsory, in the interests of safety the SRSDC race organizers strongly recommend the use of Personal Protective Equipment.
- > You will be running in alpine conditions and it is recommended that you carry suitable alpine clothing.
- Under our Risk Management Plan all dogs (whether racing or coming onto the mountain) must have a current vaccination certificate.
- Dog Class Changes will only be accepted up until an hour (60 minutes) prior to each bib draw meeting as per timetable. These must be made to Sarah Campbell howlingheights@xtra.co.nz or by phone 021 313 481. NO DOG CLASS CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER THESE TIMES. The only exception to this will be for Race 2 and Race 4 due to dog injury in consultation with Race Vet.
- Class Limits The committee reserves the right to request novice snow mushers be limited to a maximum of 3 dog class.
- > The race organizers reserve the right to reduce any team size should they feel the musher is trying to control a team beyond their capabilities.
- It is compulsory for all double lead dogs to be connected by a neck line.
- > Please note the Ski Field trails remain open to the public whilst the races are in progress.
- ➤ The "Southern Hemisphere Proving Ground" car testing facility and sheds/workshops that are adjacent to the ski-field, is a restricted access area, car testing facilities will still be operating. **Do not enter** the restricted area's unless you have the express permission of the SHPG manager.
- Cancellations Refunding of entry fees is at the discretion of the SRSDC committee.
- Trail Use:
 - Never use any trail on race days without clearing it with the Trail Boss or Race Co-ordinators
 - · Do not approach the Snow Farm owners directly regarding trails or facilities
 - If you intend using the trails to practice on the days before or after you are responsible for paying your own trail fees at the Snow Farm office.
- ➤ All media and press coverage in relation to the Wanaka Sled Dog Festival must be approved by the Race Co-ordinator.
- > All vehicles/trailers with doos must not be parked directly in front of the lodge area
